A bylaw to authorize the disbursement of monies in the water and land "Capital Asset Replacement Fund".

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies imposed under Bylaw No. 129 (Improvement District's "Capital Asset Replacement Fund Bylaw") for the purpose of water tower replacement and compound upgrades.

The Trustees of the Piers Island Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- The sum of (\$380,525) is hereby appropriated from the water fund, and the sum of (\$25,000) is hereby appropriated from the land fund of the "Capital Asset Replacement Fund" to be expended on water tower replacement and compound upgrades.
- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated will be specified and authorized by resolution of the Trustees.
- Should any of the above amount remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, any unexpended balance will be returned to the credit of the said Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the Capital Asset Replacement Fund Disbursement 2020 Bylaw No. 129.
