

**PIERS ISLAND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
TAXATION BYLAW 2023, NO. 137**

A bylaw for imposing taxes upon lands in the Improvement District and to provide for imposing a percentage addition to encourage prompt payment thereof.

The Trustees of Piers Island Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the year 2023, there is hereby levied a flat parcel tax of One Thousand and Two Hundred Fifty-Two Dollars (\$1,252) on all parcels of land within the Improvement District.
2. The aforementioned taxes shall be due and payable on or before the thirty-first day of August 2023, and a percentage addition of ten per centum of the amount thereof shall be added to all taxes remaining unpaid after the said date.
3. In addition, taxes remaining unpaid after the first day of March next following the date upon which the taxes are levied shall bear interest at the rate prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the Local Government Act, part 17, Improvement Districts, Section 717. The interest is from day to day deemed part of the taxes, and a reference to taxes is deemed to include all interest so added and is to the same extent as the taxes a lien and charge.
4. This bylaw may be cited as "Taxation Bylaw 2023".
