The Piers Island Emergency Program (PIEP) is part of the Southern Gulf Islands Area Program providing services during an island emergency. Our major task is to support the work of the Piers Island Volunteer Fire Department (PIVFD) whose members respond to on-site emergencies while the PIEP works off site at an Emergency Operations Centre.

Regular training is provided either through the area program or the Justice institute of BC. At least twice per year the Emergency Program holds training exercises with the PIVFD. Last September we held our yearly earthquake exercise and in June we organized a very well attended simulated evacuation of the island.

Communication is a vital part of any emergency response. The Piers Island call-out system, otherwise referred to as the telephone tree, is the major method we use to connect with islanders during an emergency. Please ensure the Emergency Program (EP) has your up-to-date land-line and cell phone numbers, and contact Sandy Brunham at <a href="mailto:sbrunham@gmail.com">sbrunham@gmail.com</a> with any changes. Please note the EP directory is not the same as the Island Phone Book. The directory is used by members of the Emergency Program for emergency purposes only.
