



ROAD COMMITTEE Annual Report September 2021

As a preamble, it is worth restating that the Road Committee is tasked with coordinating maintenance of the road as part of the Memorandum of Understanding between PIID and the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MOTI) to ensure safe and reliable access to PIID equipment for water operations, emergency services, fire protection and maintenance of infrastructure.

Over the course of the past year, we have filled potholes regularly and as required in the wet winter season. In the dry summer season, we have applied a dust control saltwater solution to the roads on several occasions. We cut all the long grasses on the roadside verges this spring.

In February 2021, the Road Committee recommended that due to heavy rains in January followed by heavy snowfall, PIID suspend issuing permits for heavy vehicles to access the Dolphin Ramp for transit to Piers Island and that MOTI suspend issuing permits to access McKenzie Crescent. We appreciate your support for and understanding of these necessary measures.

We encourage everyone to keep the road allowance free of trailers, vehicles, and building materials - this would be a great help to us. Most islanders are very good about this but not all. And with many children on the island now and with many of us walking the road regularly, golf carts are best driven slowly.
