The new ramp gate was successfully installed on May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023.



New parking blocks were installed in late 2022. Each stall is now clearly identified and is 8.5ft wide as per Vancouver and Victoria standards. We now have 48 parking spots including 4 large trailer stalls at the southwest corner.
