

Piers Island Improvement District

Bylaw No. 92

A bylaw to amend the authorized expenditures of monies from the Capital Water Works Renewal Reserve Fund establishment bylaw.

The Trustees of the Piers Island Improvement District **ENACT AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Bylaw No. 53 “Capital Water Works Renewal Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw” is amended as follows:

Section 4 is deleted and replaced by the following revised section 4.

Monies in the Reserve Fund shall only be used for expenditures for upgrading the water system including the following:

- a. Reconstructing the control vault along with all mechanical and electrified components.
- b. Installing a dedicated supply line to the storage tank.
- c. Installing a new storage tank.
- d. Installing water quality maintenance and recording systems.
- e. Creating improved access to stored water.
- f. Replacing deteriorated water supply pipe and other system components.
- g. Replacing deteriorated service connections.
- h. Installing double check valves on all services.
- i. Renewing and increasing ground reservoir capacity.
- j. Removing obsolete system components.

2. This bylaw may be cited as the “Capital Water Works Renewal Reserve Fund Amendment Bylaw 2008.
