PIID Meeting – November 28, 2023

The summer went smoothly on all accounts and a short summary of current initiatives is provided below.

• Infrastructure Update

- On October 4, 202, a car was broken into at the Dolphin Road Compound and minor items were stolen. Police were called and Canoe Cove Marina also experienced boat break-ins that night. A reminder to all to lock vehicles and to not leave any valuables overnight in them.
- Design solutions and costing were done to install video surveillance at the Compound. To be discussed under "New Business" at this meeting.
- The dry hydrant at the south reservoir was repaired by Bob Crooks and Gerry Kristianson. Thanks to both of them.
- The EV Committee has finalized the EV Solution Report presented under On-Going Business" at this November meeting. As per the Terms of Reference of the EV Select Committee, this report provides an overview of what a long-term EV solution in the Compound could look like. The recommendation is to set aside funding for future infrastructure upgrades related to new assets. It is important to note that the solution should be refined at a later date. It does however clearly highlight the government initiatives and policy constraints that the PIID will face in the coming decade.
