



PIID Buildings & Land Improvements Trustee's Report April 2021

PIID Meeting – April 6, 2021

- Compound Project – Project Update document and survey are currently with Islanders until April 11. Gate replacement will happen in April along with some drainage work along the south perimeter.
- Road Committee & Road Status – Road was closed for approximately 10 days following a wet winter and heavy snowfalls. Thanks for everyone's cooperation. Starting November 1, 2021, MOTI will request that all permit requests be done via their online permit process and a minimum of 15 days will be required prior to permit issuance. A formal MOTI permit will be required to access the road and to get a PIID compound permit.
- Compound
 - Reminder - With the spring and summer season starting, and the current parking pressure, all Islanders using the Compound are asked to park efficiently. The PIID will regularly check vehicles and ensure compliance with bylaw 115.
 - Sailboat removal – After one of the winter storms, a sailboat ended up blocking the Compound boat ramp. After contacting Coast Guards and Transport Canada, ramp access resumed within 72 hours.
- Communication with Connected Coast Project – Email sent to the Project Contact to include Piers Island as part of the project (fibre optic). A huge thank you to Chad Rintoul (#61) for his help contacting our federal and provincial representatives (Elizabeth May and Adam Olsen) to add to our request (see attached communication from Elizabeth May's office).
- Other tasks include issuing compound access permits, communication with MOTI with regards to permit access on McKenzie Crescent, and other communications with Islanders.
