Water Quality and Testing Update

The water operators were able to report continuing excellent lab test results. Details are stored and available to any landowner.

Recent activities

- Eye wash station tested and refreshed
- Feasibility of and options for more robust emergency generator explored
- Water team meeting scheduled for September 12th

Upcoming projects

- Clean out Lower Reservoir storage shed
- Consolidate water team storage
- Perform inspection of water line to service line connection (seeking signs of corrosion)
- Service air valves
- Install water service markers and replacement valve box covers where appropriate
- Install 'No Anchoring' signs (delayed to accommodate purple marten nesting)
- Replace emergency generator

Routine maintenance

- Weekly water tests
- Underwater line testing
- Visual inspection of tank and pumphouses
- Emergency generator maintenance
- Service air valves

Annual meter reading

In early October the annual meter reading takes place. Be sure there is easy access to the valve box containing your meter and that it is clearly marked for the volunteer team.

Water tank replacement project

Stantec Consulting has provided our team with a report containing recommendations for three optional sizes of bolted- steel, glass-lined tanks. Stantec has also provided us with budgetary estimates for tanks of varying sizes. We, as a team, are currently considering which configuration to recommend to the PIID Trustees.
